STATEMENT OF FAITH

SHO Guidelines

Parents please initial each guideline as you read through them with each of your children. Have kids sign at the bottom that they agree to be accountable to these guidelines. You may sign for your very young children to indicate that you will be working with them on these points at Home School Connection.

When at Home School Connection, the student agrees to:

SERVE:

_____ **Help cheerfully when asked and look for ways to help others without being asked.**

_____ **Leave a space in as good or better shape than it was found.**

HONOR:

_____ **Handle church and HSC equipment and property respectfully.**

- Walk, don't run, in the building (except when appropriate).
- Respect that the playground is for kids 3rd Grade and younger.
- Use only the areas open to HSC.

_____ **Be on time and prepared for class and chapel and don't leave until dismissed.**

- Use the bathroom and get a drink before or after class.
- Have any assigned homework finished and ready to turn in on time.

_____ **Listen attentively in class and chapel.**

_____ **Speak in a manner that honors others.**

- Use titles of respect with adults (Mr. or Mrs.).
- Use kind and encouraging words with others.

_____ **Behave in manner that honors others.**

- Be a good role model and show kindness to others.
- Avoid roughhousing and fighting.
- Wait for your turn patiently (in line, to speak, with toys...).
- Refrain from pairing off with or flirting with anyone of the opposite sex alone or in a group.

_____ **Dress modestly**

This quick **Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes Test** sums up our modesty policy:

- **Head**-Can the adult or student raise their arms over their head and not have their midriff show?
- **Shoulders** – Are they covered? (No off the shoulder or spaghetti straps)
- **Knees** – Can the adult or student lean over and touch their knees without someone seeing down the front of their shirt?
- **Toes** – Can the adult or student reach down and touch their toes without someone seeing their back or down the back of their pants?

_____ **Refrain from bringing, using, or talking about media and electronic devices and/or objectionable reading material.**

- Clothes need to be media free.
- Cell phones are permitted *but* may *not* be used during class. Ringers must be off and students may not check messages, make calls, text or handle phones during class or chapel without preapproval by parent and teacher.
- Laptops are also permitted, *but* may only be used during study halls or with teacher permission. No online access will be permitted. For special circumstances, contact the administrator.
- Teachers may use media and/or discuss it when appropriate for their class.
- First time violations of this policy will result in the confiscation of the device for the remainder of the school day. Second time violations will result in confiscation of the device until parents meet with the administrator.

OBEY:

_____ Follow directions cheerfully.

_____ Participate in all the activities the teacher has prepared.

_____ Be where you are supposed to be (with your parent or a "ticket"-another adult that your parent has asked to care for you).

_____ Leave weapons at home (weapons include-guns, air-soft guns, paintball paraphernalia, and knives). A small pocketknife or multipurpose tool may be carried and used by students with parent approval and adult supervision.

Fast Track Behaviors:

There are five behaviors that will lead to the immediate removal of a student from the class.

1. Fighting, i.e. striking in anger with the intention to harm the other student.
2. Obscene, vulgar or profane language as well as taking the name of the Lord in vain.
3. Rebellion, i.e. outright disobedience in response to instructions.
4. Dishonesty in any situation while at school, including lying, cheating, plagiarism, and stealing.
5. Disrespect shown to any adult at HSC. The adult will be the judge of whether any disrespect has been shown.

Disciplinary Action Steps:

- The student will be brought to the on-site parent, or if he/she is teaching, the student will be attended in the resource room until a parent can come.
- A zero grade will be given on any related academic assignments.
- A conference between the student, teacher, administrator, and the parent will be scheduled.
- These behaviors result in suspension until repentance and reconciliation occur. Without repentance, expulsion may be necessary and parents will remain responsible for any remaining financial commitment.

I agree to be accountable to the SHO guidelines and understand that if I do not follow them, I may be asked to leave class and not come back until I meet with the teacher or an HSC leader and my parent.
